

Fire/Fuels

Fire staff are supporting the western fire season, specifically in the southwest, Region 3. When not on travel status for support purposes in the southwest, they have been helping with other tasks on the district such as mowing, maintenance and laying out cedar units for the Joint Chiefs project.

Recreation

Summer recreation is in full swing. All recreation areas on Ava and Willow Springs are open again. Pavilion (Noblett and Shell Knob) reservations are still not being taken yet because of social distancing requirements. We do ask that if you use a pavilion on a 1st come/1st serve basis that you practice social distancing. The Shell Knob Recreation Area on Cassville remains closed and the restrooms at Big Bay Day Use and Pine View Tower trailhead remain closed.

The Big Bay boat ramp repair contract on Cassville has been awarded. The work will begin when the water has receded.

Olivia is in the Resource Assistant Program and will be a customer service representative at the Cassville office and will be assisting with the recreation program.
